Bring America's history to life in the new Museum of Liverpool.

Colonel de Peyster, a native of New York City, was a commander in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Michilimackinac and later in Detroit during the American Revolution. He retired to Scotland and was friends with famous Scottish poet Robbie Burns (also known as Rabbie).

Colonel de Peyster's snowshoes are severely damaged from woodworm and are undergoing repair. The estimated cost for repair is \$1,500.
