## **Further Research**

Ship photographs can also be researched by contacting the yard where a ship was built. The series of publications, Lloyd's Registers (available at libraries or other repositories within most large cities with a maritime/shipbuilding history), normally list the place of build and the shipbuilding yard. If the yard is no longer in existence, then a further search could be made to find out if the records from the shipbuilding yard have been transferred to an archive. The publication below (which should be obtainable from your library on inter-library loan), is a useful source for locating shipbuilding archives:
